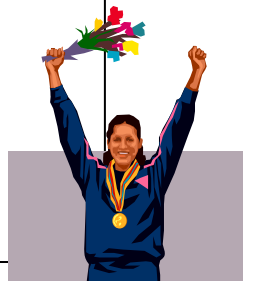

A short story is a type of writing that generally focuses on one or two main characters who face a single problem or conflict. There are several collections of short stories in the library.

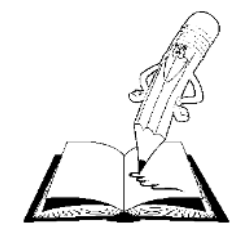
