Darcy has 5 more than Lucy. Darcy has 2 more than Tom.

Mia has 6 eggs.
How many eggs do they have altogether?

Starting from their home, they walk in a straight line on a bearing of $160^{\circ}$ for a quarter of an hour, at an average speed of $1.5 \mathrm{~m} / \mathrm{s}$. They then turn due East and walk in a straight line for 1 km . Calculate the distance and bearing of their destination from their home.
