

A Student Guide to Learning Remotely

Here are the most important apps that you should know to set yourself up for remote learning...










ClassCharts – your "to do" list


- This is the **"go-to" app** that teachers will use to set you homework, or lesson work during any school closure
- ➤ Treat it like your "to-do" list and tick off work when you have completed it
- Teachers can see whether you have or haven't looked at the homework set
- ➤ **Download the app** to your phone and write down your pupil log-on code. Ask your tutor if you've forgotten it






Accessing your Email and OneDrive


To log on to your school email from home, visit The Willink website www.willinkschool.org.uk and click **Login**






➤ You will arrive at the RM Unify login screen willink.rmunify.com






To email a teacher, type the first few letters of their last name.

≻OneDrive




Your OneDrive allows you to create Word and PowerPoint documents for free and save them in folders.

> Teams – seeing all your Teams




Each of your classes and tutor group will set up a Microsoft Team.

This is where any live lessons will take place, either on your phone or even better, on a PC




>Teams – joining a live lesson
