Dear Parents and Carers,

We are thrilled to announce the first of our fundraising discos of the academic year. Our Year 7 “Ice Breaker” Disco will take place on Thursday, 15 October, 7-9pm in the main school hall.

This is a great opportunity to **Engage** and “embrace opportunities to be our best, in and out of lessons”. Prior knowledge of the Macarena and Cha-Cha Slide is not essential!

This is a fundraising disco with funds supporting a selected charitable organisation and the school “technical fund”. The latter supports school productions – such as “Willink Meets Broadway”, ‘Legally Blonde’ and ‘Peter Pan’ our most recent productions.

- Tickets cost £3
- Students should purchase tickets from the main school office during morning break (cash only)
- Tickets will be available from Monday 5th October.
- Students will receive a numbered ticket and should present this upon arrival at the disco.
- Students should be dropped off and collected from the Main Hall, Leisure Centre entrance.
- Staff will supervise collection and students will be asked to remain on site until they have been collected by their responsible adult.
- “Resident DJ’s” will finish promptly at 9pm (despite requests for encore)
- Students should bring money in the form of coins should they wish to purchase items (soft drinks, sweets, chocolate and crisps) from our in-house “tuck shop” which is not associated with Harrison (fingerprints will not work). The event will be “cash only” and we kindly ask that students do not bring notes.
- To ensure safety, students must remain in our disco venue until the end of the evening.
- Neither students from other year groups nor other schools will be permitted to attend.

The biggest dilemma for some students is, “What should I wear?”

Of course, students do not need to wear school uniform but clothing with drink, tobacco or drug related logos are not permitted.

The Year 7 Ice-breaker disco is always an enjoyable activity - including for the staff on duty!
